Pocket cards are great! Scrapbooking with them is quick as a flash, just slip some photos and cards into pocket pages and "presto!" your layout is done!

But... is that really all you can do with pocket page cards?

If you are ready to take your pocket cards to the next level here's 10 creative ways to take your pocket cards out of the pocket! Most of these tips can be applied to traditional, digital and hybrid scrapbooking.

# 10 Creative Ways to Take Your Pocket Cards Outside the Pocket

#### Outside the packet image 1

1. Cut pocket cards to create new embellishments for your layout.

6. Place half of a folding card OUTSIDE of the pocket for interaction with hidden journaling.


