How did you get to find the Campus?

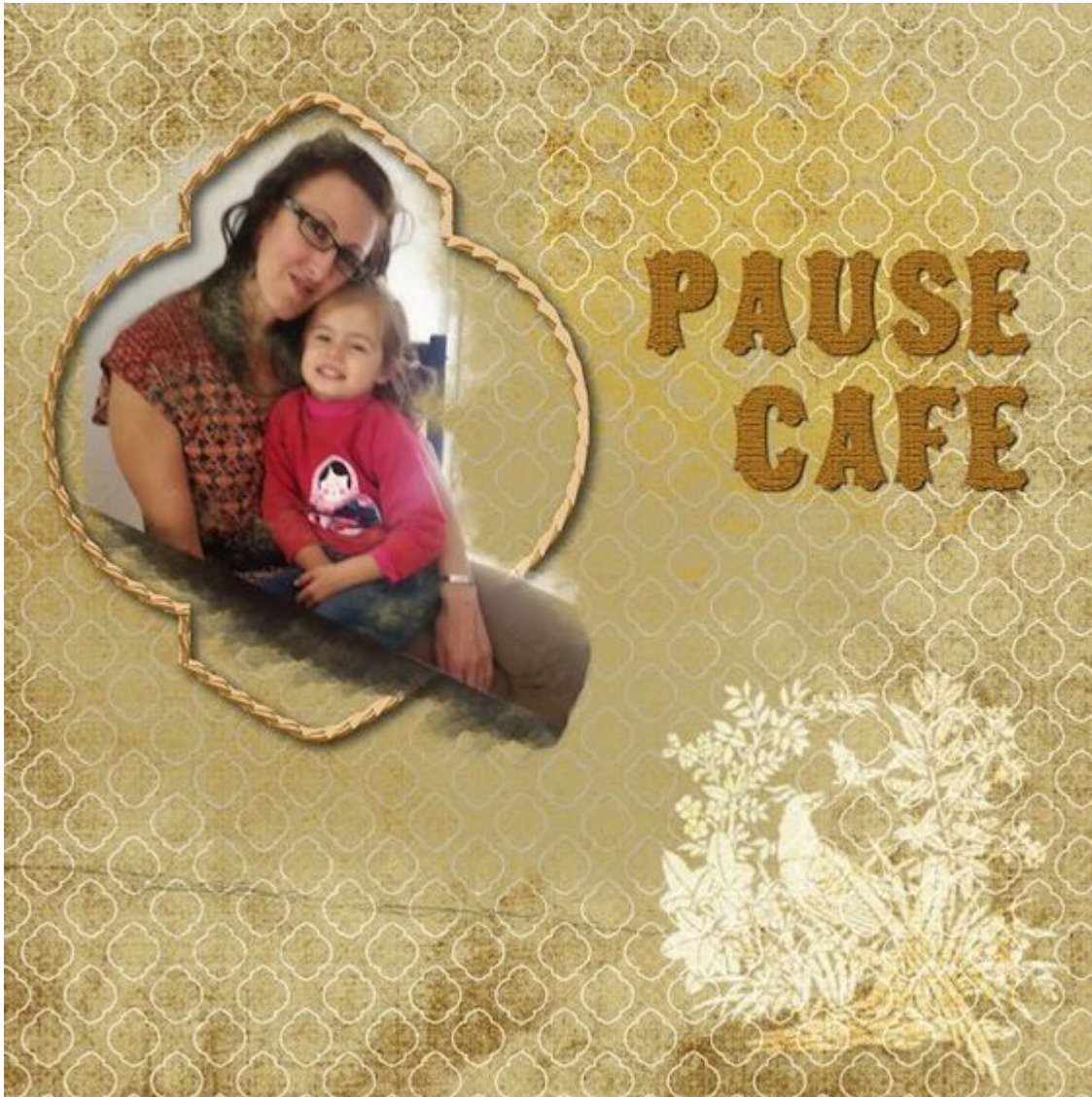
