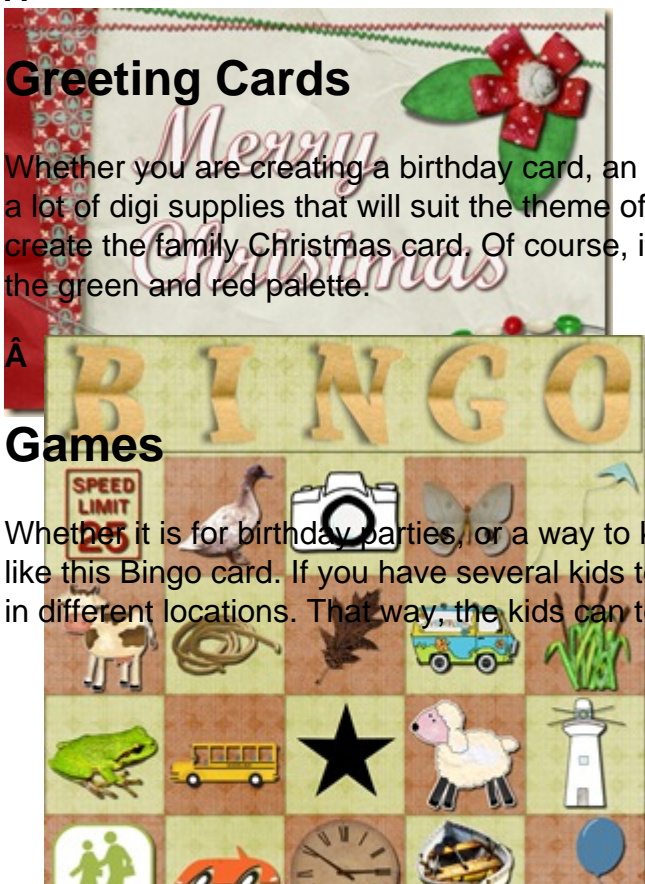
Greeting Cards
